ABPS National Exhibition at Scottish Congress 2019

Exhibit Hand-in

The Exhibition is being held on Friday/Saturday 12/13 April 2019.

Exhibitors will be able to hand-in via the Bin Room at Perth and uplift from the Bin Room. Exhibitors will not mount or dismount their own exhibits.

Hand-in at the Exhibition

We recommend this is only done in person. The Bin Room will be operational from **10am on Thursday 11 April**. Judging is expected to commence at 3pm on Thursday, so you only have a small window for hand-in at the Exhibition.

The exhibition closes at 3.30pm on Saturday 13th April. Handback is expected from the Bin Room around 5pm – but could be earlier.
